SALARY INCREASE TRACKING – IT'S NOT SERIOUS...

Dear Members,

We checked to see if the regulatory changes allowing establishments to pay you your salary increases were included in the latest edition of Wednesday's Official Gazette of this week, and they were not there!

We therefore had a meeting with our counterparts at Santé Québec (SQ) on Wednesday to ask them the reasons why their own managers are still not being paid. They beat around the bush, they don't really know what to tell us: bonuses, MSSS lawyers, Ministry of Justice lawyers...

We had a meeting on Thursday afternoon with the SQ representative who is also beating around the same bush, without much explanation and who confirms to us, already in advance, that the regulatory changes will not be in the Official Gazette of June 18th... this is not serious, we're being played!

Thus, we asked you to write the following text to your MP:

As a manager in the health and social services network, I managed the pandemic, vaccinated Quebecers, provided essential services during the unionized employees' strike, and I still don't have my salary increases. You, as a deputy, have received them. The executives of Santé Québec obtained a 10% increase. All unionized employees and all managers in all public and parapublic sectors have had their raises, except us... and we are told that it will not be shortly... Why?
