SALARY INCREASE MONITORING – WE DON'T GIVE UP... TO YOUR PENS!

Dear Members,

We checked to see if the regulatory changes allowing establishments to pay you your salary increases were included in the latest edition of the Official Gazette on Wednesday of this week, and they were still not there!

We have a meeting with our counterparts at Santé Québec (SQ) tomorrow to ask them why their own managers are still not being paid. We will come back to you later, but it is clearly unacceptable... Everyone gets paid except us!

We therefore ask you to write again to your MP, because it clearly had the effect of putting pressure:

I'm a manager in the health and social services network and I'm still not paid. MNAs, police officers, firefighters, union members, managers from CEGEP school service centres, the government and Santé Québec have all already received their salary increases. We had an agreement with SQ and TBS on March 28 and I still don't have them... Why? Is it because we are mostly women that it can wait? When I had to deal with the pandemic and the strike, I made sure to proceed as quickly as possible and by giving countless hours without being paid.

I expect to know when my employer will be able to pay me my wage increases.
