**1. Accident and health insurance**

Certain priorities have been identified by the group insurance technical committee for the coming year. We want to discuss the increase in the reimbursement granted to executives during a professional service, to include in the contract the use of cannabis for therapeutic purposes, drugs covering erectile dysfunction, care provided by kinesiologists as well as telemedicine coverage. All of these topics will be covered over the next year with SSQ.

**2. List of unauthorized service providers... Warning!**

Beneva (SSQ) currently refuses any reimbursement if an insured presents a request for reimbursement from a supplier on the list of suppliers who are not authorized. Beneva (SSQ) set up this list because some suppliers have questionable or unethical practices, and this, after several reminders from Beneva. These providers have an obligation to disclose to their customers that they are not covered by the Insurer... but not all of them do. So be careful and you can find this list in the Customer Space in the "Documents" section (List of ineligible suppliers).
